| <b>Step #1 Drywall Installation</b>  |   |   |
| <b>Steps to Complete Job</b>   | <b>Hazards</b>  | <b>Preventive Measures</b>  |
| Install drywall to walls and ceiling framing.  | Worker has the potential to be exposed to strains, sprains, cuts, trips, flying debris and falls. | 1) Additional PPE: Cut level 4 gloves. When overhead work produces particles, gasketed safety glasses or a clear face shield with safety glasses are to be worn.  |
|  |   | 2) Use proper lifting techniques. Lift with legs and square up with the work. Avoid twisting while lifting.   |
|  |   | 3) Avoid overreaching while using screw gun or router.  |
|  |   | 4) All benches MUST have leg locks installed. Benches will be inspected by the foreman before being allowed on the jobsite. Benches will then be inspected daily, prior to each use the bench top should be clear of debris, and the path leading to the bench and area around the bench must be clear of debris. |
|  | Worker has the potential to be exposed to electrical hazards, loud noise.                         | 1) Hearing protection is strongly recommended. Hearing protection is required when noise exceeds of 85db.   |
|  |   | 2) Ensure the task area has proper ventilation. Use an N-95 dust mask as needed.  |
|  |   | 3) Inspect electrical tools and charger cords for defects or damage prior to use. Red tag and replace as needed.  |
|  |   | 4) Sprinkler heads must be protected by others before installing board around them.   |
|  |   | 5) When using a router overhead, position body away from debris field to avoid getting dust in eyes.  |
|  |   | 6) When finished in an area broom sweep using Kleene Sweep or N-95 dust mask.   |
